



## Course Overview

There are many challenges in modern dental practice; more patients with complex medical histories, more patients with complex pain problems, the availability of more complex diagnostic tools, and increased patient expectations regarding treatment with the attendant risk of litigation should the outcome be perceived as sub-optimal.

This two-day course considers these issues; the management of oro-facial pain, the impact of medical co-morbidities on the provision of care, planning for surgery and managing problems that may arise during or after a procedure, and the use of modern imaging technology.
